Automobile allowance rates

The automobile allowance rates for **2012** are:

- 53¢ per kilometre for the first 5,000 kilometres driven; and
- 47¢ per kilometre driven after that.

In the Northwest Territories, Yukon, and Nunavut, there is an additional 4¢ per kilometre allowed for travel.

The automobile allowance rates for **2008**, **2009**, **2010** and **2011** are:

- 52¢ per kilometre for the first 5,000 kilometres driven; and
- 46¢ per kilometre driven after that.

The automobile allowance rates for **2006** and **2007** are:

- 50¢ per kilometre for the first 5,000 kilometres driven; and
- 44¢ per kilometre driven after that.
